NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern these Show. Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany these Show Premium List.

A recording fee of 50 cents and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. These AKC fees are to be collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2)

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONA MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All Trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

RETURNED CHECKS/INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

The show-giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by email prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$5.00 and less will not be issued due to the cost of processing.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 7:00 am each show day. Dogs must be removed DAILY from the show site immediately following completion of the last scheduled class. All dogs present must be on leash or confined except when being judged. Do not leave dogs is closed vehicles.

Exhibitors must keep dogs under control and restrained at all times. Crating allowed only in designated areas. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external

parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Utah State Law requires all dogs over four (4) months of age be current on rabies vaccination.

Exhibitors Must be governed by any rules and regulations of the Salt Lake County Equestrian Park and/or local restriction. Dogs not entered at these shows are not allowed on the show grounds. All dogs present must be on leash or confined except when being judged. Failure to comply will result in charges being brought before the Show Committee.

The Show Committee reserves the right to make such other regulations as they may deem necessary (not to conflict with AKC rules) on the day of the show.

The judging procedure may be modified to accommodate disabled handlers.

Entries must be submitted on an American Kennel Club Official Entry Form or exact copy (both front & back) and must be signed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks. The Club and/or its Show Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry or for entry in a class for which the dog is not eligible to compete or entering the same dog twice.

IMPORTANT COVID-19 INFORMATION

The Utah Shetland Sheepdog Association (the "Club") will prioritize the health and safety of its members, exhibitors and others in attendance at these specialty shows. As such, the Club will enforce social distancing rules and other guidelines implemented by the Governor of Utah, the State Department of Public Health or other state or local government agencies in response to the Covid-19 pandemic and in force at the time of our shows.

These Public Health Guidelines are subject to change at any time and could, under extreme circumstances, require the cancellation of our shows for reasons beyond the Club's control. The Club will take actions to mitigate health risks to the best of its ability.

The Club is pleased to be able to hold our specialty shows and the exact grounds show may change the day of show. The event may be held OUTDOORS vs. INDOORS which will facilitate safe social distancing for exhibitors, spectators, members and our judges. Other precautions may be taken to adhere to Public Health Guidelines, including limiting the number of chairs around the show ring and requesting that attendees try to stay at least 6 ft. apart where possible.

The Club will ask our judges to allow extra time for exhibitors and their dogs to reach the ring, if necessary, to avoid crowding at ringside.

The Club will adjust its schedule of events as necessary in response to the public health conditions in place at the time of our shows.

Everyone entering their dogs at these specialty shows and attending the event for any reason is aware of and accepts any public health risks that may exist at the time and is fully responsible for the consequences of their own actions. Although the Club intends to follow Public Health Guidelines, it accepts no responsibility, financial or otherwise, for loss, damage or injury that may occur as a result of anyone's participation of any kind in these shows.

If it should become necessary for the Club to cancel these shows for any reason, prior to the closing date for entries, any entry fees received will be refunded in full in a timely manner to the person that made such entries and in the form he or she made them.

If the show must be cancelled after close of entries, the Club will retain that portion of the entry fees that are needed to offset unavoidable costs of the show and intends to refund the balance.

Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
